

GRSC will be participating in the 2021 International Summer Sailstice

From New Zealand, the Philippines, French Polynesia, San Francisco Bay to GRSC at Muskegon Lake, sailors from all over the world will hold a local event to be part of the International Summer Sailstice. GRSC is signed on to join the group!

Begun in 2001, Summer Sailstice is the global sailing holiday celebrated on the weekend closest to the summer solstice. Founded on the basis that the non-sailing public doesn't really understand sailing and most public awareness comes from events or tragedies that don't accurately represent sailing (America's Cup, Thurston Howell III, etc), Summer Sailstice was created to unite, celebrate and showcase life under sail, and to be a lot of fun! Every year Summer Sailstice unites over 20,000 sailors across the oceans to celebrate and showcase life under sail.

We plan to leave the Grand Haven pierhead to sail for Muskegon at noon on Saturday, June 19, where we can spend the night anchored off Muskegon State Park (in one of the bays just inside the pierheads) as a sunflower if we have enough for that- definitely in group form. If poor weather keeps us from sailing and gathering to spend the night, we will take a land cruise to a local restaurant and celebrate there, setting another time for anchoring off Muskegon State Park.
